The Authority's Executive Management Team and Public Information Officer will recommend to the NYS Bridge Authority Board the name of the proposer(s) that they believe is best qualified per the specifications to provide the services required. The Authority Board retains total discretion to designate the best qualified proposer, and to award or refuse to award a contract.
